INFORMATION FOR RUNNERS

Welcome to the 1987, N.B. Road Racing Series Racing!
There are 22 races from which you may earn series points. Twelve of these are grouped into a "Super Series". Races in the Super Series will be Special in three ways:

- 1) There will be more points awarded twice as many for some runners.
- 2) Only Super Series points will be used to calculate provincial standings.
- 3) Super Series points will be required to earn the higher Series awards.

GRAND PRIZE:

The men and women's Series winner will receive a runner's travel prize package to a major race (to be announced). Trip winners must be N.B.T.F.A., or Run N.B. members.

AWARDS: All runners will be able to earn one of five awards. These awards are now replaced with certificates in five colors. Points from any of the 22 races may be tabulated toward the Green, Red, and White certificates, while Super Series points must be used when calculating totals for the Silver Award. Blue certificates will be given to the top runners in the provincial standings. Runners may claim only one certificate - the highest one earned based on the following standards:

GREEN LEVEL	5 points in at least 3 races
RED LEVEL	25 points in at least 3 races
WHITE LEVEL	75 points in at least 5 races
SILVER LEVEL	30 points from Super Series
BLUE LEVEL

Top 10 females	
Top 5 master females	In Provincial Standings
Top 10 masters	
Top 5 veterans	

* **PROVINCIAL STANDINGS:** These will be calculated using the results of Super Series Races only. In order to be listed an athlete must:
a) be a New Brunswick resident

b) compete in at least one Provincial Championship (Marathon May 31 Moncton 20km - August 9, in Riverview, or 10km September 19 Fredericton)

NOTE: For Certificate Awards and Provincial Standings, end of series points will be tabulated from up to 7 races. If 8 or more races are run, points will be calculated using the best of 7 finishes.

INFORMATION POUR LES COUREURS

Bienvenue à la série des courses à pied de la province du Nouveau-Brunswick pour l'année 1987.
Il y a 22 courses, dont vous aurez à choisir de, pour accumuler des points dans la série. Douze de celles-ci établiront la "Super Series". Les courses du Super Series seront spéciales de trois manières:

- 1) Il y aura plus de points à gagner, jusqu'à deux fois plus pour des tels coureurs.
- 2) Les points accumulés dans le Super Series, seront utilisés pour établir votre rang provincial. S'il vous manque jusqu'à 2 courses, vous pouvez vous servir de 2 des autres courses qui ne font pas partie du "Super Series".
- 3) Faut utiliser les points du "Super Series" pour essayer d'accueillir les plus grands prix.

LE GRAND PRIX:

Le gagnant et la gagnante de la série cette année vont recevoir un prix qui consistera d'un voyage à une course majeure (à être annoncé plus tard). Les gagnants des voyages doivent être membre de N.B.T.F.A. ou courses N.B.

PRIX: Chaque coureur sera capable d'obtenir un des cinq prix. Ces prix ont été remplacés par des certificats de cinq différentes couleurs. Les points accumulés de n'importe laquelle des 22 courses, peuvent être additionnés pour les certificats Verts, Rouge ou Blanc, tandis que les points accumulés dans la Super Série seront additionnés pour les certificats d'argent et pour les Bleus - qui seront donné aux meilleurs coureurs au Rang Provincial. Chaque coureur a droit de recevoir un certificat seulement, le plus haut étant donné selon les règlements suivants:

In all races, record breakers will receive a bonus 5 points. Only one runner per category per race will receive record breaking points - even if two or more runners are under the old record.

TIES. (Provincial Standings) When points are equal, the runner receiving the higher standing will be the one who had the best finish in his / her races. If the tie remains, the second best races will be considered. This will continue as necessary, for the 3rd, 4th, etc. best races, until the tie is broken.
