RUN NEW BRUNSWICK ROAD RACING SERIES 1994

Welcome to the 1994 New Brunswick Road Racing Series. There are 23 races which form the NB Racing Circuit. Thirteen of these are grouped into a Super Series. Races in the Super Series will be eligible for a higher point system than the Regular Series.

Provincial standings will be calculated using the results of both Super Series and Regular Series races. The final standings will be derived using up to seven races. If eight or more races are run, points will be calculated using the best seven finishes. To be eligible for points, an athlete must be a member of Athletics New Brunswick prior to the race. In order to receive a ranking in the 1994 Run New Brunswick Provincial Standings he/she must:

- 1) be a New Brunswick resident
- 2) be registered with Athletics New Brunswick as a member of Run NB

Points will be calculated based on finish position within each respective category. All finishers will receive at least two points. In all races, record breakers will receive a bonus of five points. Only one runner per category will receive the record breaking points if applicable - even if two or more runners break the same old record.

When two or more runners finish the season having an equal number of points, the runner receiving the higher standing will be the one who had the best finish in their races. If the tie remains, the second best race will be considered. This will continue as necessary for the third, fourth, etc. best race, until the tie is broken.

Bienvenue aux series des course à pied du Nouveau-Brunswick pour l'année 1994. Il y a 23 courses dans les Series auxquelles vous pouvez participer et accumuler des points. Treize de celles-ci établiront les Super Series. Les courses dans les Super Series seront éligibles pour un système de point supérieur des Series régulières.

Pour le rang provincial, les points seront attribués selon les résultats des Super Series et des Series régulières. En ce qui concerne les rangs finals, le pointage total sera déterminé d'après sept courses. Si vous avez 8 courses ou plus, les points de vos sept meilleures courses seront additionnés. Pour recevoir des points au rang provincial, il faut être membre d'Athlétisme N.-B.

Pour obtenir un rang provincial des Courses N.-B. 1994, l'athlète doit:

- 1) être un résident du Nouveau-Brunswick
- 2) être membre d'Athlétisme N.-B. comme membre de Courses N.-B.

Les points pour les catégories seront établis selon leur position dans leur catégorie. Au moins 2 points seront donnés à chaque finissant. Il y aura 5 points bonus, au coureur qui établit un nouveau record pour la course. Seulement un coureur par catégorie, par courses, pourra recueillir ces points même si deux ou plus sont classifiés comme le meilleur temps.

Lorsque les points sont égaux, le coureur qui recevra le plus haut rang avec les meilleurs temps dans ses

courses. Si l'égalité persiste la second meilleure course sera considérée. Ceci continuera pour la troisième, quatrième course, etc. jusqu'à ce qu'un gagnant sera déterminé.

ATHLETICS NEW BRUNSWICK PROGRAMS

Royal Canadian Legion Track & Field

Each year N.B. Command sponsors a Track & Field Program for all N.B. athletes up to Junior Age Class. The program, on the provincial level, has three parts: (1) a series of eight (8) District Meets, (2) a Provincial Meet, and (3) a Selection Meet. Athletes advance through each with a team of 36 athletes (Midget & Juvenile) being selected to represent the provincial command at the National Track & Field Camp. In 1994 the National Camp will be held in Ottawa, Ont. The program is fully funded by the Royal Canadian Legion.

Jeux de l'Acadie

A program for Francophone athletes up to age 15, this program is sanctioned by A.N.B. It consists of 6 regional meets in N.B. (1 in N.S. and 1 in P.E.I) and a Final. The 1994 Final is set for June 30 to July 3rd at Caraquet, NB.

Canada Games

A specific ANB program with major funding from Sport Branch; this is a four year program leading to the major inter-provincial competition. New Brunswick did very well at the 1993 Games in Kamloops, BC, returning with a gold - women's discus; silver - 3000m steeplechase; and a bronze - men's shot put. Planning for the 1997 Games will begin this summer with athlete identification at the setting of team standards. It is anticipated the 1997 team will consist of approximately 49 athletes of junior and senior age (23 yrs & under) and up to 7 staff.

Jeux de la Francophonie

Due to our official bilingual status, New Brunswick, along with Canada and Quebec, is a member of La Francophonie (the French Commonwealth of Nations). As a result, N.B. has been given the opportunity to enter a team in the Jeux de la Francophonie, held every four years. This is the core of the senior program in ANB. There is no language requirement for athletes attending, but all are required to meet performance standards.

NCCP Coaching Certification

May 5th to 8th, 1994 will be date for our semi annual Atlantic Coaching School in Athletics. Technical courses will be offered in Levels I, II and III. Levels I and II are available in either english or french. The course will be based in Chatham, NB. Officials Certification

Officials in ANB are divided into eight (8) zones. Each zone is represented by a zone chairperson who is responsible for promoting and monitoring the activities within their zone. Officials may advance through the certification levels of officiating from novice to Level 5 and International Official. Clinics and upgrading are held in conjunction with all major meets in the province.
